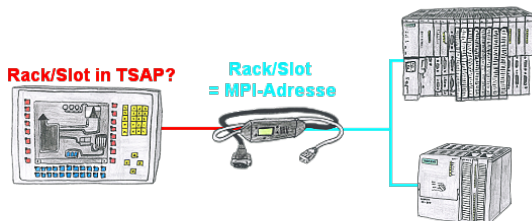

## Easy Web-Visualization



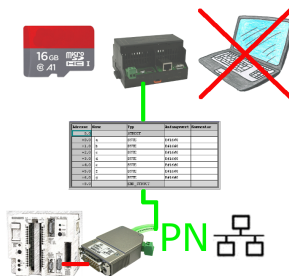

Then you have found with S7-Visu the solution. Visualizations under Windows(R)/Linux on PC-based systems are just realizable as those for tablets or Phones with browser support. The simultaneous operation of multiple browsers at the same time is possible.

## Transformation of Rack/Slot in TSAP to MPI-address



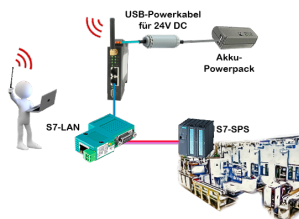

You want for e.g. moving around your system/control and need a 24V-DC-supply for your access-point ALF-UA?

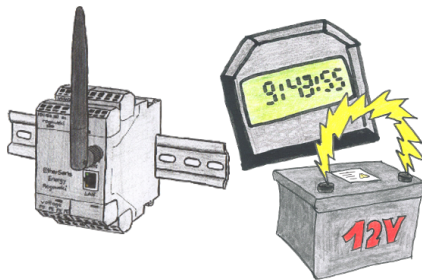
With USB-power-cable and a USB-power-bank/-accu, the problem can be solved immediately with little effort.

## Detect failure of Profinet-devices



Identify devices that are likely to fail in the near future.

## Battery buffered time



You always need a current time, but do not always have a time-server on site. With the integrated battery-backed RTC you always have the current time in the unit. Even if the power fails, the time in the unit continues to operate, so that when the voltage returns, the time continues to run correctly.
